Proof of registration at a public post secondary institution or private post-secondary school accredited with the PCTIA (Private Career Training Institutions Agency) must be provided in writing to the 861 Sponsoring Committee prior to the scholarship money being paid to the cadet.

3. A 500 word essay discussing your career objectives. To include: your short term educational goals, school preference and financial needs. Please include how your training as a cadet has personally affected your life and why you should be a good recipient of this scholarship.

**PLEASE DO NOT SEND ESSAYS IN SEPERATELY – ATTACH TO YOUR APPLICATION FORM**

Please note that the quality and relevance of your essay will account for a large portion of your total score. Please refrain from repeating the same information that you provided under 'Cadet Information – To Learn, To Serve and To Advance.'
